



Guidelines For Theory Examination Vocational Programmes

Dear Student,

01. Examinations will be held in hybrid (online/offline) format with MCQs (Multiple Choice Questions) and Descriptive Questions in 3 hours duration.
02. The timings for Theory examination will be from 10:00 am to 01:00 PM.
03. You will need a smart device/gadget for appearing in the examination, e.g., Desktop or Laptop or Smart Mobile Phone, with camera. You will also need an uninterrupted strong internet connection, and uninterrupted electricity backup. Without all this, you will not be able to appear properly in the examination.
04. The Mock test and BOSSE Examination will be held on the following link :

05. In order to give Mock test OR Examination, you will have to enter your Registration number/Enrolment number) and DOB (DDMMYYYY format).
06. You are advised to appear in the MOCK Test to develop your comfort level to take the current examination. The Mock Test will be available for 2 days i.e. 26th and 27th of December, 2025. It will start by 10 am on 26th December and end by 2 pm on 27th of December, 2025. Mock test can be given just once so utilize your time properly.
07. The exams will begin from 6th January 2026 and will end on 9th January 2026. Kindly refer to the student portal for Date sheet.
08. All candidates are requested to check their details along with subjects and photo in the student zone of bosse.ac.in before appearing for Examination. Discrepancies in detail or photo should be removed before examination by students or centers. No request will be entertained on the day of examination.
09. Admit Card will be available on student panel on 24th of December, 2025. You can download the same from there.
10. Kindly note that for descriptive questions, you will have to write down the answers in the ruled sheet and upload all the sheets together at UPLOAD ANSWER Section as displayed on the left-hand side. Every answer should have the reference of Question number. For e.g. Answer to

have your registration number on top along with the name of the paper and date. File may be uploaded in JPEG or PDF format.

11. After uploading the Answers and completing your paper, you must click on SAVE & SUBMIT tab for final submission of your paper. Review everything thoroughly before submitting your paper as paper once submitted cannot be overturned.
